

what is Konect?



Konect is a serverware solution that makes centralized software applications, files, data and web services available to remote and mobile staff, wherever they work, by 'publishing' these applications to their computers. **Konect** seamlessly integrates these networked resources into user computers in a highly secure manner without the confusion of second terminal services Windows desktop.

what does Konect do?



With **Konect**, businesses are able to install and locate all of their software, files and data on a central server(s). Using the **Konect Management Console**, an administrator then assigns user rights to these resources and when a user logs on to the network, Konect intelligently deploys access to these resources within their existing computing desktop.

what do I need to use Konect?



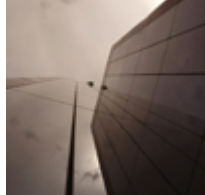
Konect must be deployed on Windows 2000 or Windows 2003 Server (*it cannot be deployed on Small Business Server 2000 or 2003*) and requires Active Directory. Each user whom accesses a resource published by **Konect** requires a **Konect** Connection License and a Terminal Services Client Access License. **Konect** will work with an existing VPN infrastructure or can be deployed with SSL and the **Konect** Secure Gateway. All other software required is installed during the **Konect** installation process.

what do I get with Konect?



If you purchase the **Konect Starter Kit** you will receive the **Konect** Server software, 2 Concurrent Connection Licenses, the Installation Manual and the User Guide. You may also acquire Connection Licenses in pre-packaged quantities of 5. It should be noted that you do not receive Terminal Server Client Access Licenses with your purchase. You need to ensure these are in place or you must acquire them to be able to use **Konect**.
